One of these is that the patients' well-being must be served - medically, but also in terms of equally knowledgeable and thoughtful care, and all this in buildings that are as practical as they are good to look at. Bosch followed the same principles in his work as an industrialist. Bosch was interested in promoting public welfare as well as his highly successful business activities. Since 1964, 92 per cent of Robert Bosch GmbH has belonged to the Robert Bosch Foundation, whose dividends benefit education, science, understanding among nations and health care. So in 1973 it became possible to open a new hospital complex in Auerbachstrasse, in north-east Stuttgart. There has been continual extension and improvement of the existing stock by Arcass Freie Architekten, and in recent years the geriatric rehabilitation clinic and the very stimulating chapel in the south corner have been added, both by Günter Leonhardt, and also the entrance building by Joachim Schürmann & Partner, this last with an ambience that is scarcely reminiscent of a...
