With a libretto supplied by Thomas Morell, Handel s great work was first performed at the Theatre Royal, Covent Garden, on April the 1st, 1747, as part of his annual Lenten season of oratorios. By the time of Handel s death in 1759, Judas Maccabaeus had become the composer s second most popular oratorio, having received 33 London performances under the composer s supervision (Messiah had 36).
