Jas, Harlan, of Iowa, in the Senate, January 11, 1861 There is but one alternative with a law-abiding people: the fundamental law must be obeyed, or lawfully changed; and no one, anywhere, has proposed so to change the Constitution as to erase this provision. Its terms are not ambiguous; it provides that - No person held to service or labor in one State, under the laws thereof, escaping into another, shall, in consequence of any law or regulation therein, be discharged from such service or labor, but shall be delivered up on claim of the party to whom such service or labor may be due. The Republican national convention did not propose any amendment to this part of the Constitution; no Republican member of either branch of Congress has ever proposed its abrogation; no Republican governor, or State Legislature, or State convention, has ever demanded it. The assertion that the Republicans are opposed to this provision of the Constitution is a sheer fabrication, asserted in the first instance...
