The international coalition that is imposing progressively strict economic sanctions on Iran has broadened and deepened, producing significant effects on Iran s economy. U.S. officials believe that these sanctions-which are now targeting Iran s oil export lifeline-caused Iran to return to the nuclear bargaining table in April 2012 with greater seriousness and intent toward peaceful resolution. Many judge that Iran needs an easing of sanctions because the energy sector provides nearly 70 of Iran s government revenues. Iran s worsening economic situation is caused by: A decision by the European Union on January 23, 2012, to wind down purchases of Iranian crude oil by July 1, 2012. EU countries buy about 20 of Iran s oil exports. This action took into consideration an International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) report on Iran s possible efforts to design a nuclear explosive device, and diplomatic and financial rifts with Britain,...
