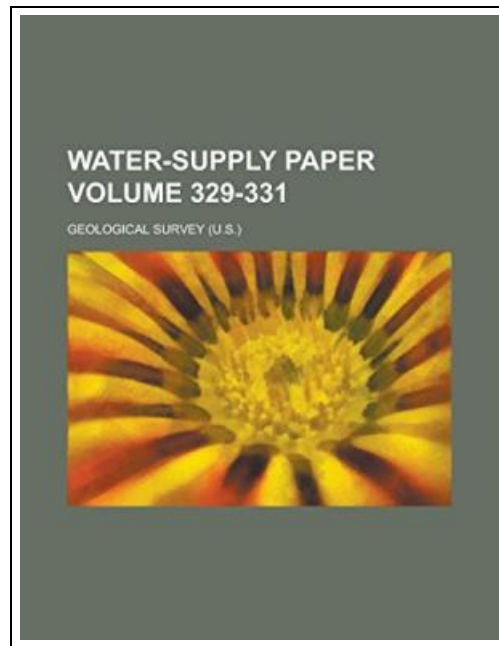

Conns mill ditch diverts water from the left bank about 250 feet below the gage, where a low timber...
