This second volume of The Tannins is devoted to the results of investigation by the author on the astringent principles from nine species of oaks and one species each of mangrove, canaigre, and chestnut. In accordance with the announcement made in Volume I., there has been associated with these results so much descriptive matter, from the author's observations and other sources, as has been necessary to complete a foundation for the intelligent study of the subject. The sources of these tannins have received careful attention, and every precaution taken to insure the genuineness of the samples from which the tannin was extracted. The various oak barks were collected by the author himself or his assistant, with the exception of two samples, one from Dehra Dtin, India, the other from Herefordshire, England. The two last-mentioned specimens were obtained in anticipation of a possible criticism, that only the tannins from the oaks of Northeastern United States were investigated. Having employed material from three different quarters of the globe, it is reasonable to assume that the conclusions regaining...
