The error, in giving the Song upon occasion of the dinner in honour of Lord Melville's acquittal to the wrong party, is explained in the notice prefixed to Sir Walter Scott's Song. In both instances the evidence of authorship seemed positive and conclusive, yet, in both instances, it turned out to be erroneous. The Errata, so far as discovered, are enumerated in the note.
