It follows the semi-autobiographical story of an orphan named Christie Devon, who, having turned twenty-one, announces a new Declaration of Independence and leaves her uncle s house in order to pursue economic self-sufficiency and to find fulfillment in her profession. Against the backdrop of the Civil War years, Christie works as a servant, actress, governess, companion, seamstress, and army nurse--all jobs that Alcott knew from personal experience--exposing the often insidious ways in which the employments conventionally available..
