Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder (ADHD) is not an easy road to travel. It is a mental health condition that affects about 1 in 10 children ages 5 to 17. There are different levels of severity of this disorder, and unfortunately there is often a gap between having the condition and being diagnosed with it. Studies show boys are nearly three times more likely to be diagnosed than girls. In recent years, acceptance of ADHD diagnostics has become easier. Yet it remains a controversial topic in many families, especially in minority communities. Cultural factors play a role in ADHD acceptance. Sometimes the discussion turns into pointing fingers at parents for not applying the right level of discipline or structure for...
