The major buildings within the fort are described separately like the Lahore and Delhi Gates; the Naubat Khana; the Diwan-i-Aam; Rang Mahal, the Shah Burj; the Asad Burj etc. The book has 2 large plans: one is the ground plan with dimensions, and the other is a sketch of a birds eye view of the fort and its interior. This book is a reprint of the 1914 edition.
