A bard, on the other hand, is a professional poet employed to compose eulogies for his lord. In Scotland in the 16th century it was a derogatory term for a traveling musician. Flute Dream is a short fairy tale written by Hermann Hesse in March 1914, when he was about to turn thirty seven. The story, which was titled Flotentraum in German, deals with the subconscious dream world and is based on two of Carl Jung s shadow archetypes, the Impotent Lover and the Weaking King. In Jungian psychology, the poet is one of the main manifestations of the Lover archetype. The Lover archetype is usually the first that develops...
